Perry, Hocking, Lawrence, Monroe, Washington	USDA Forest Service, Wayne National Forest	\$10,000.00	All Wayne National Forest Horse, Mtn. Bike, and OHV Trails - Ed. Program -Education program for Wayne N.F. for ATV rack cards, OHV maps, and ATV mini-maps.
Perry, Hocking	USDA Forest Service, Wayne National Forest	\$185,633.00	Main Corridor Trail -This project will widen 6 bridges in the Main Corridor Trail to provide for side-by-sides and the redesign of all ATV bridge approaches.

Cuyahoga	Euclid	\$150,000.00	Sims Park Trails -Project includes 4000 L.F. of multi-use paved trails through Sims Park and along its Lake Erie waterfront. The project also includes a Sims Park trailhead with additional parking.
Ottawa	Danbury Township Board of Trustees	\$43,317.00	Note: This project has been recommended for funding out of the Clean Ohio Trails Fund in the amount of \$126,343.00. Engineering & construction of an ADA accessible 3,855 L.F., 8ft wide asphalt paved non-motorized trail. It will connect to an existing 3,150 ft ADA accessible asphalt trail.
Wood	Perrysburg	\$59,412.00	Rotary Community Park -Develop 3625 linear feet of multi-use trail
Delaware	Orange Township Parks	\$120,000.00	Lewis Center Rail Trail North-Phase 2 -Phase II construct .2 miles of trail from East Orange Rd. to Glen Oak Park.
Delaware	Genoa Township	\$100,000.00	McNamara Park Trail -Project includes the extension of an existing trail at a community park called McNamara. The extension will be 8,544 L.F. of asphalt trail.
Hamilton	Hamilton County Park District	\$25,560.00	Mitchell Memorial Forest Mountain Bike Trail -To project entails the construction of 4 miles of trail, 4 miles of maintenance/grooming of trails and 6 to 8 acres of restoration.

Construction of an 8 ft. wide 3,400 LF between the Bright Water Sub-division and Pataskala Ridge Subdivision along with one wooded bridge.

The project includes two sections of new paved trail totaling 6,316 square feet, an outlook point, culvert/drainage, fencing, signage, site furnishings and the site preparation.
